

Chaperone Expectations for Group Visits

Chaperones play a vital role in maintaining a positive learning environment during group visits. Please review the following information regarding chaperone responsibilities and share it with your staff.

- 1. Central Washington University requires 1 chaperone for every 10 students.
- 2. Chaperones must stay with their group at all times.
- 3. Ensure that students stay with the group and do not wander off without permission.
- 4. Encourage respectful behavior and discourage disruptive or disrespectful behavior.
- 5. Serve as a role model for students by behaving appropriately and professionally. Please refrain from talking on your phone or having conversations with other chaperones or students while on the tour or during presentations.
